**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

**1.1** The races and series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

**2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

**2.1** The Oriental Dinghy Club (ODC) is the organizing authority. The series is open to all ODC full members with an Ensign, Laser, or Sunfish. Additional classes may be added if demand is there.

**2.2** Racing Classes:

Lasers and Sunfish may have a common start. Ensigns will have a separate start.

**3 SCHEDULE**

**3.1** Registration: Registration is not required.

**3.2** Dates of Racing: The official schedule is posted on the ODC website.

**3.3** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1100.

**3.4** Number of races: Normally three or four are sailed. This may be changed by the fleet captain and or the race committee.

**3.5** At the conclusion of racing each day ODC will provide drinks and snacks at the home of Charlie Carpenter, 800 Oriental Lane. Skippers and crew are invited.

**4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**4.1** The sailing instructions are available on the ODC website.

**5 THE COURSES**

The Signal Boat will set a starting line in the waters off of Oriental. The course will be Windward/Leeward for all classes.

**6 SCORING**

**6.1** Results will be posted on the ODC website.

**6.2** Ensigns will be scored on the low point system.

Laser/Sunfish will be scored on the long series average system.

**6.3** Boats must sail in a minimum of 50% of the races to be eligible for the series trophies.

**7 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

The Race committee may use VHF channel 72 to advise competitors.

**8 PRIZES**

Trophies will be awarded at the ODC Annual Meeting. The number of prizes awarded will depend on participation in each class.

**9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
